This scholarship includes

- + full-tuition coverage for four years (eight semesters) through MSU's Spartan Tuition Advantage;
- + \$3,000 annual housing stipend for your first two years in MSU's on-campus housing;
- + personalized support and mentorship through the Detroit M.A.D.E. Scholars Program, which focuses on college transition, graduation and career development.

Requirements to renew the scholarship every year

- + Maintain enrollment at MSU and good academic standing (cumulative GPA of at least 2.0)
- + File your FAFSA every year (fafsa.gov)
- + Continue to meet the program's income eligibility criteria (total household income of \$65,000 or less)



How to be considered for this scholarship

1. **Meet these criteria:** You attend Northwestern High School or University Preparatory Academy High School and will be applying to MSU as a first-year student. You are from Michigan, qualify for the Pell Grant, and have a total household income of \$65,000 or less.
2. Apply to Michigan State University: admissions.msu.edu/apply
3. Submit the FAFSA as soon as it opens: fafsa.gov
4. Once you are admitted to MSU as an eligible student, you will automatically be considered for the Henry Ford + MSU Scholarship.
